We've been married for twelve years and have three biological children. We've also had three miscarriages and one daughter who passed away during birth due to a fatal birth defect. We were blessed to have the time God gave us with our daughter. Unfortunately, after her birth due to complications, Heidi had to undergo an emergent hysterectomy. Although we can no longer have more biological children, we still strongly desire to grow our family through adoption.

You will be in our prayers throughout this journey and we support you during this time, regardless of your decision.



We have enjoyed our twelve years of living our lives together and raising our family. From a very early age, Heidi has always wanted to adopt and care for children who needed a family. Coming from a large family, Heidi loved having siblings and wanted to give that to another child. Having the love and support of a family was so instrumental in forming Heidi into the person she is today. We also have a first-hand connection with adoption as John's mother was adopted. She was adopted from an orphanage in Italy by her adoptive parents here in the States. Her birth mother had died and her father couldn't take care of her and her sisters so they were placed in an orphanage. However, her adoptive parents were able to find her biological family in her teen years, and she reconnected with her siblings. We are blessed to have her in our lives because of adoption. Seeing the effects of an adoption and how it affected her early life has helped us see how important open adoption is. We both have friends and relatives who were adopted as well!

When we started this journey of adoption, our major goal was to open our family to welcome another child. Along the way we have learned more about open adoption and it has shown us how very positive and important it is for you as a birth mother and for our future child to have an ongoing relationship.

gratitude


We try to instill in ourselves as well as our children to be thankful for all that we have been given from God. We try to show appreciation to our family members and share that with our children.




HOME sweet Midwestern HOME
