

OUR PROMISE


We promise to celebrate who the child is and their unique story.

We met 12 years ago as students at NDSU. Steven was pursuing a degree in Biological Sciences, and I (Kasey) was planning on being a social worker by day, and a pastor by night. We met in a campus ministry. We were both student leaders. Steven was really involved on the worship team playing guitar, singing, and leading a bible study. I (Kasey) was involved in leading a bible study, serving on the greeting team, and we were both starting to take bible classes online.

We started dating August 2013, and it became clear pretty fast that we had a lot in common, like our love for physical activity, adventure, rock music, Jesus, and we both felt lead to be college pastors.

WHY WE'RE ADOPTING

As a few years passed, we started to notice something was wrong. After some testing, and a surgery, more time passed and it became less and less likely that a biological family was possible for us.

We both felt strongly that fertility treatments weren't the direction we felt God was leading us. We have always been firm believers that a family is built with those you love and include, not just biologically. We have always tried to include our college students in our family during holidays, and so often feel like we have many, many 'kids to parent.'












Meet Fin
