
Our Story


We live in an excellent school district with a lot of diversity. There is an abundance of things to do here, with 21 city parks and plenty of natural walking and hiking paths.

Typically, we celebrate with my family (due to Alex's mom's work schedule), but Thanksgiving and Christmas are celebrated with both of our families.










The Little Things
