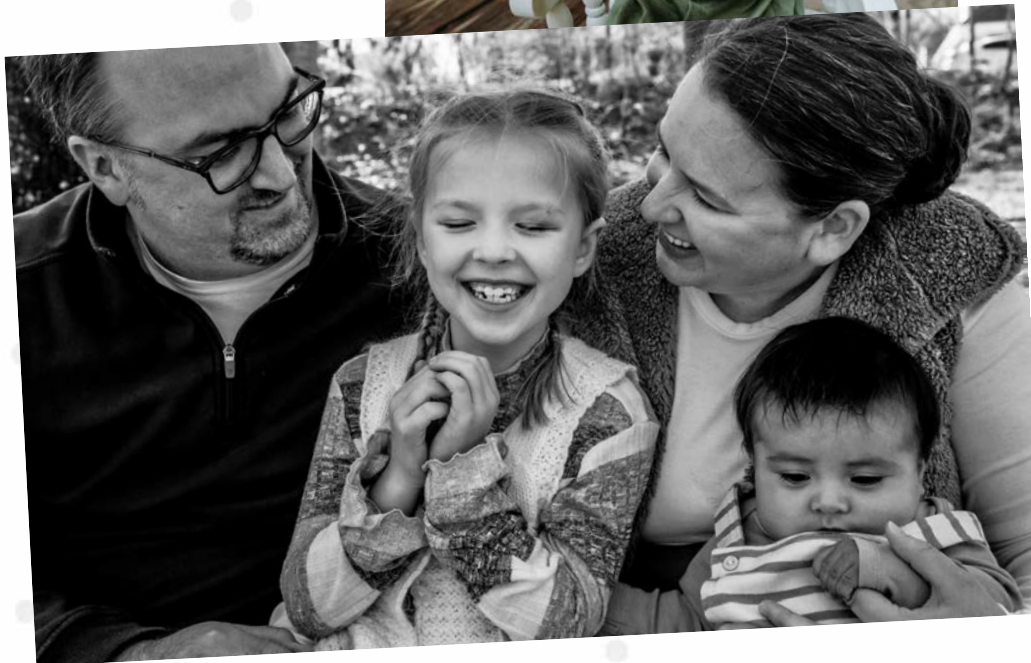

Our Family

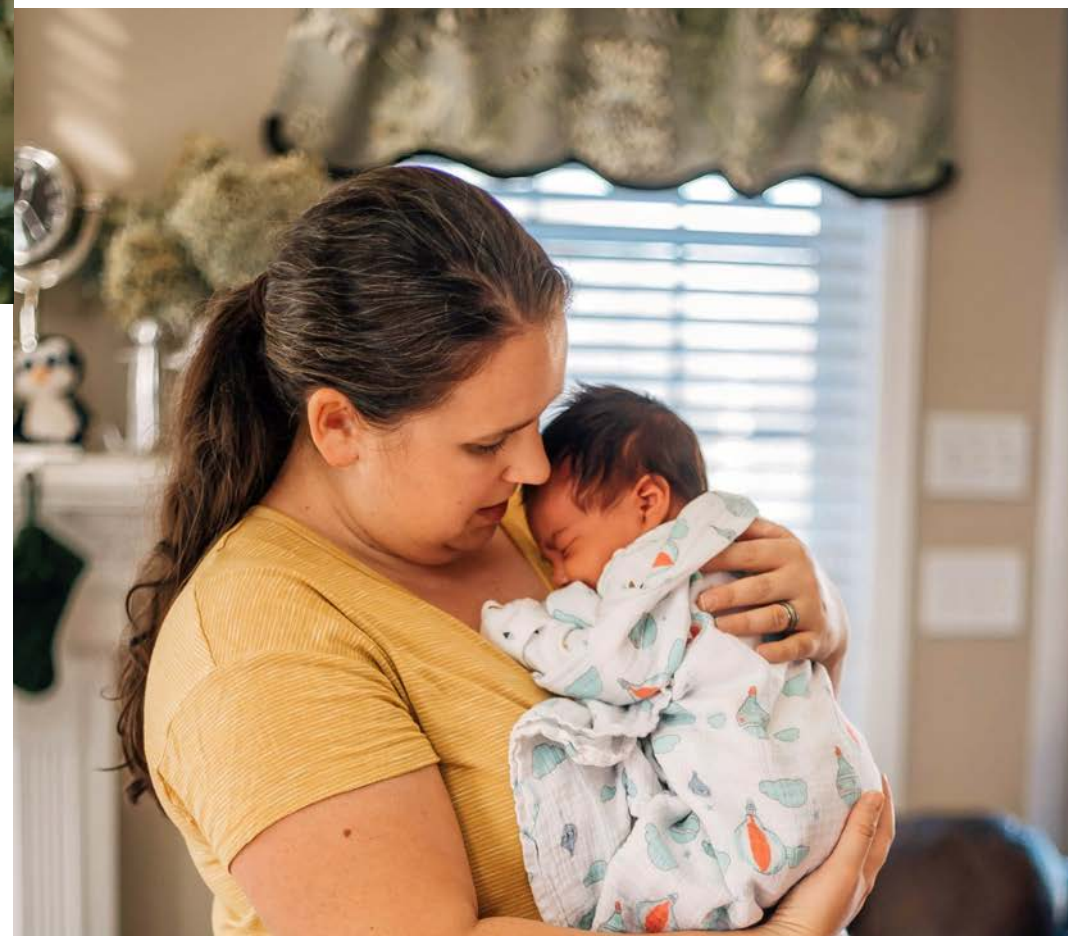
