OUR NEIGHBORHOOD

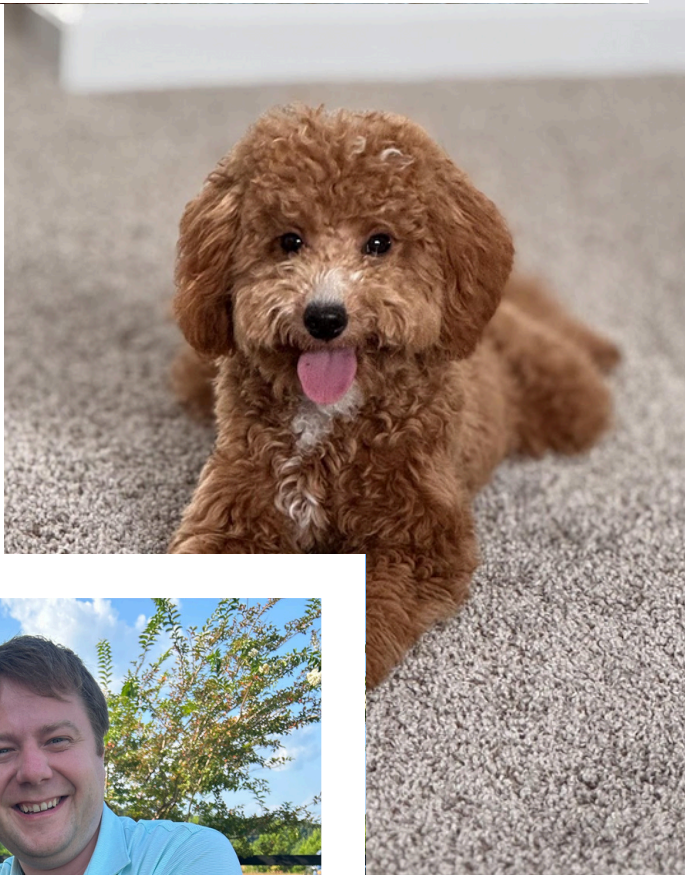

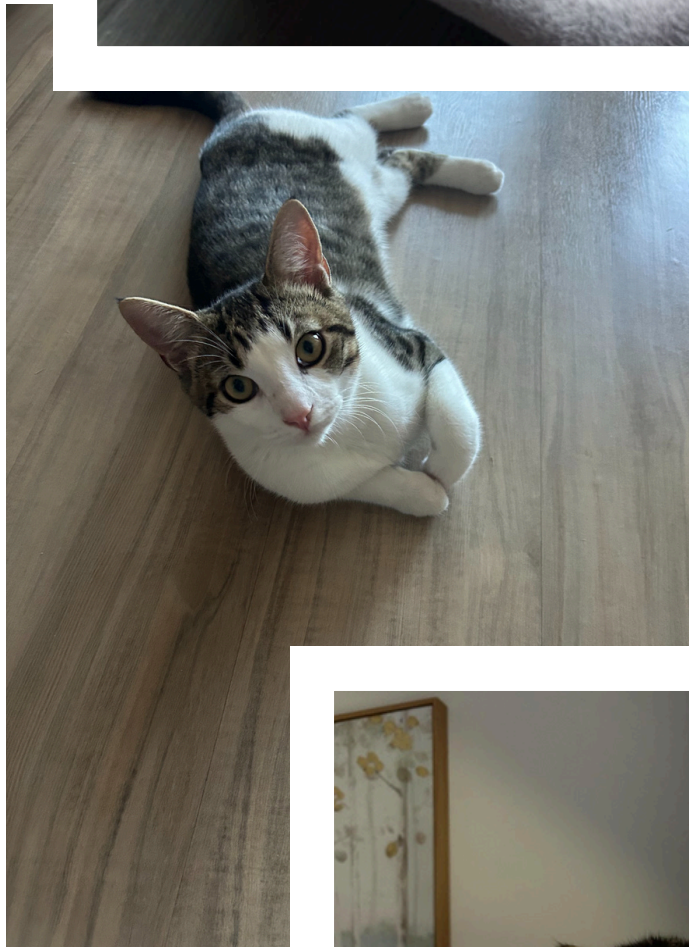
Georgia

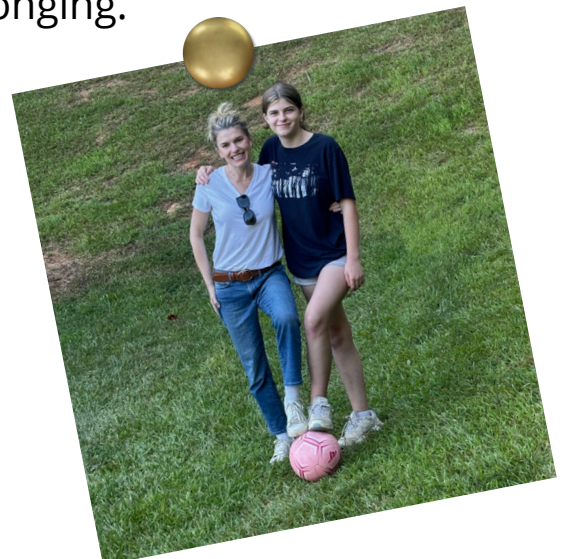
