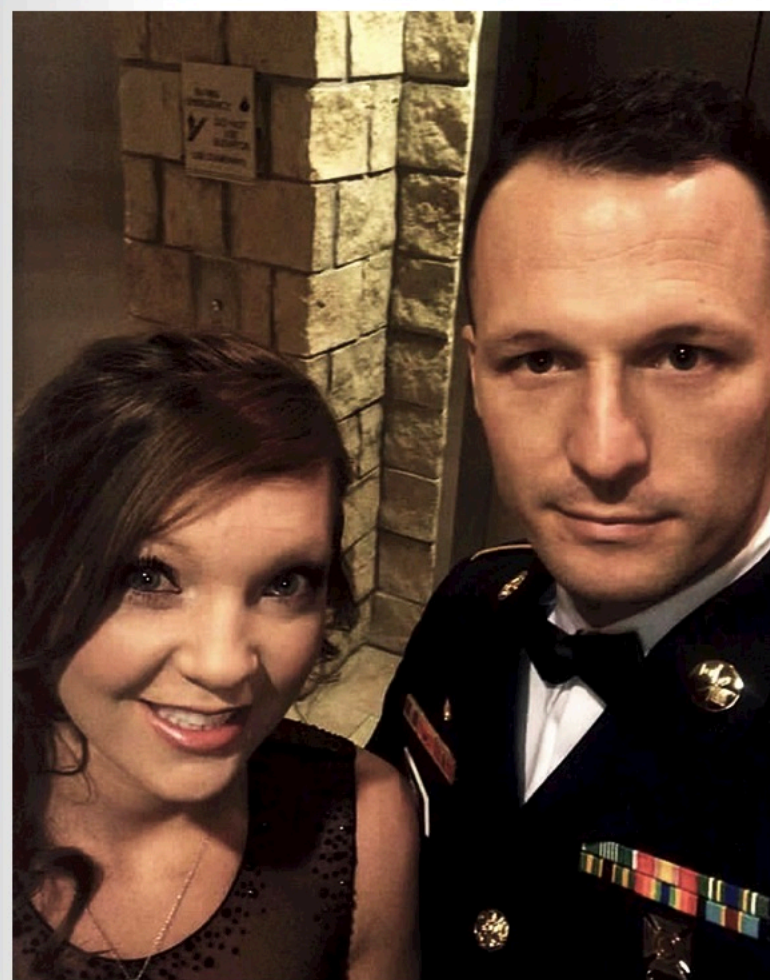


Engagement

4th of July we grill, watch fireworks, and go to events.

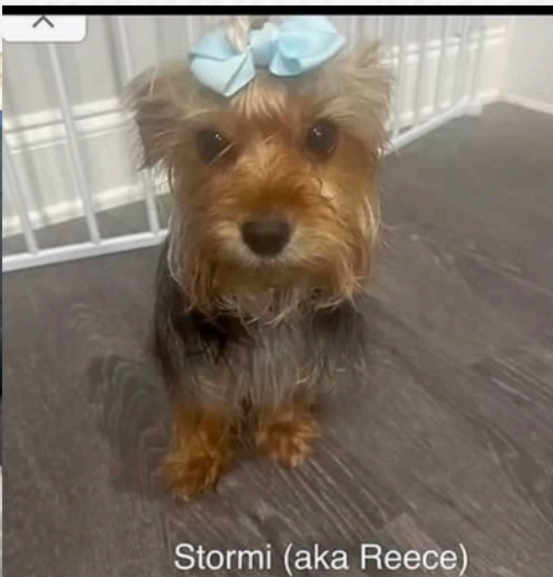
Halloween we dress up, go to events, and trick or treat. We also go to the Pumpkin Patch and kid-friendly/haunted houses.

Thanksgiving we cook, eat snacks, a big meal, and desserts. We play games and talk about what we are thankful for.

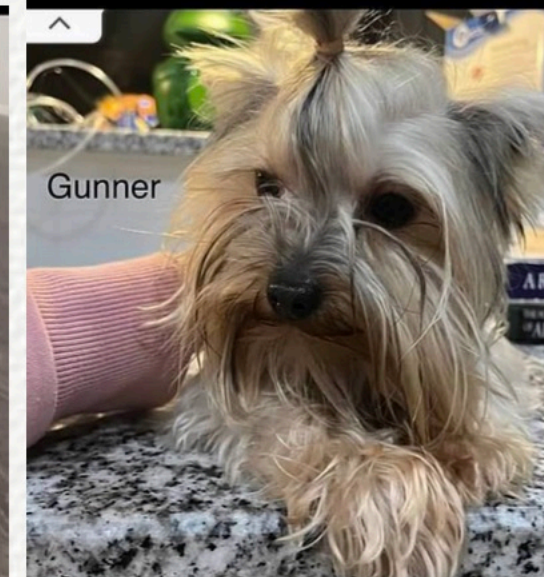

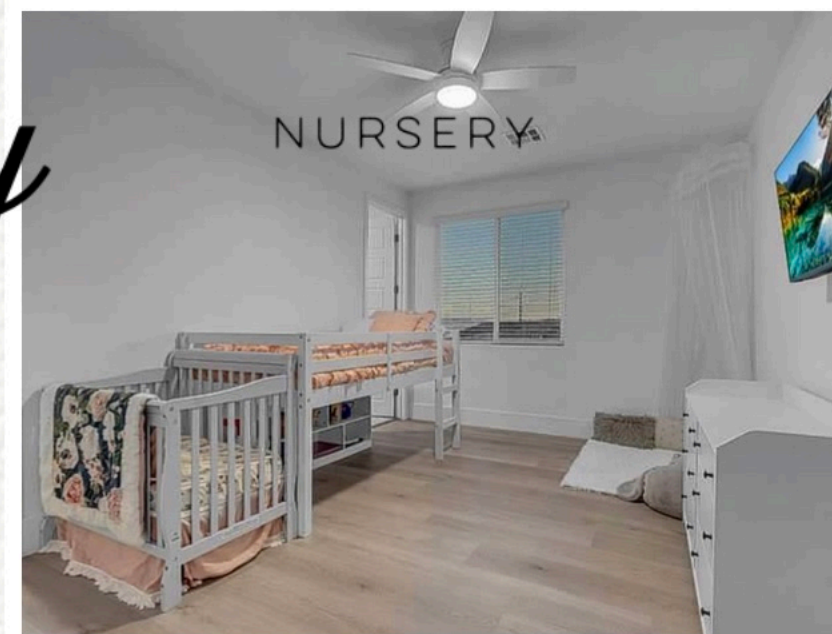
HOME


