Please know that I have deep love and respect for your journey, and I'm truly grateful that you've taken the time to learn more about me.

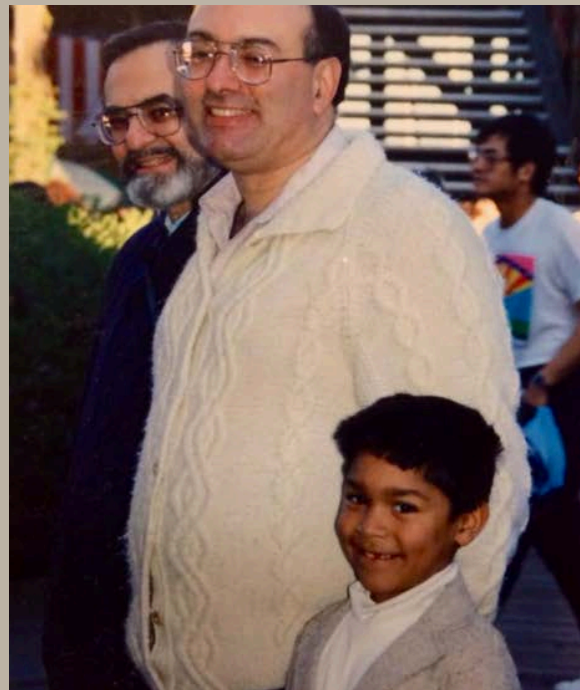

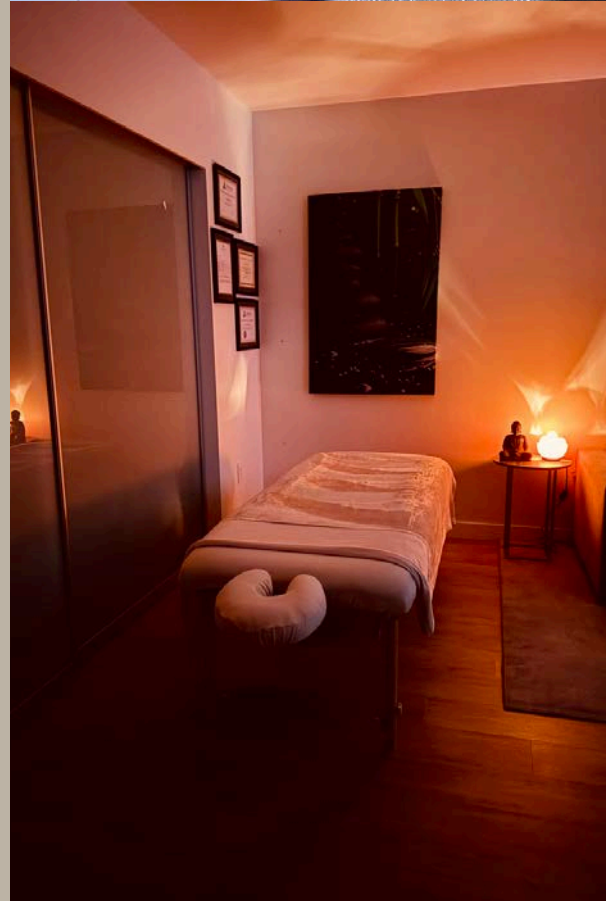
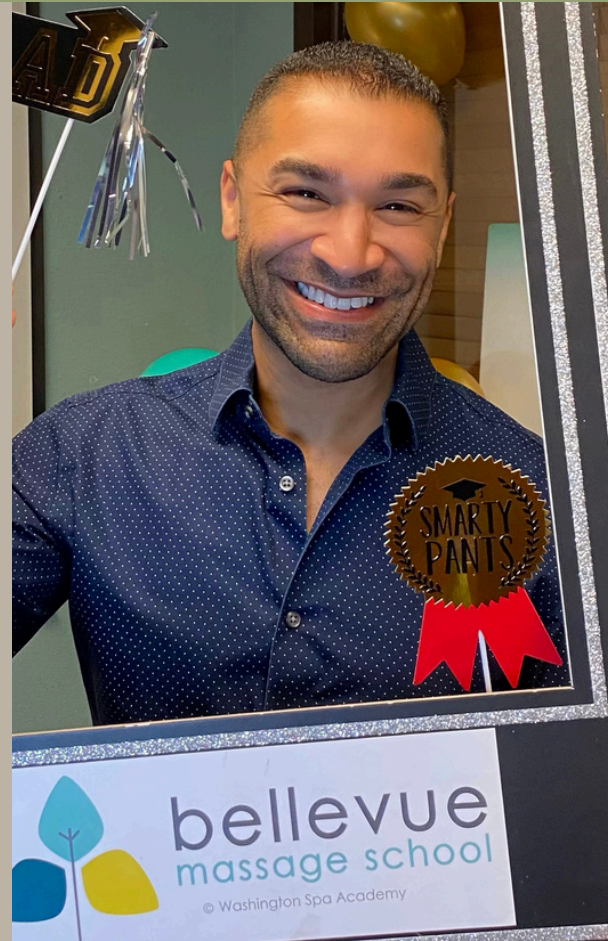
Get To Know Me.

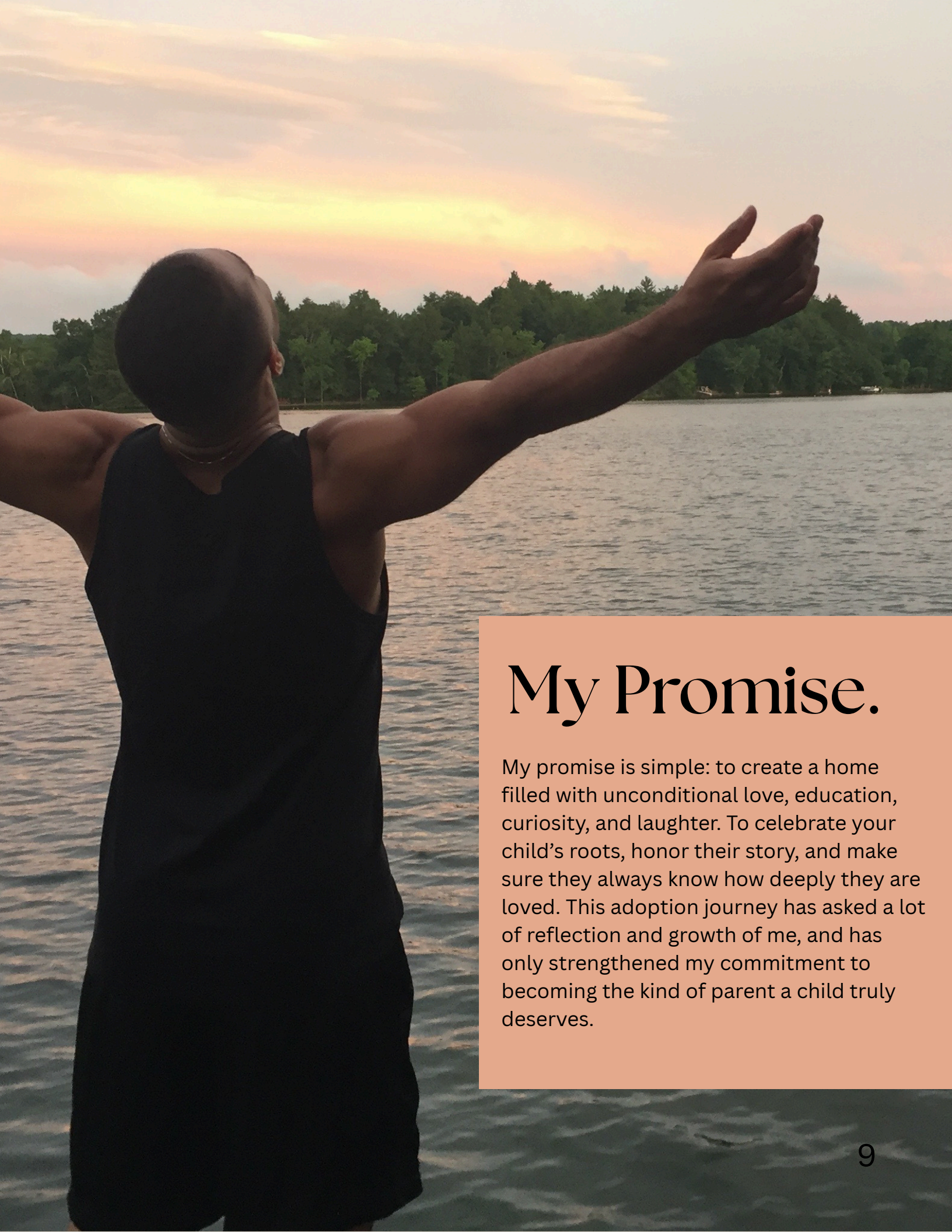


Where I Call Home.
