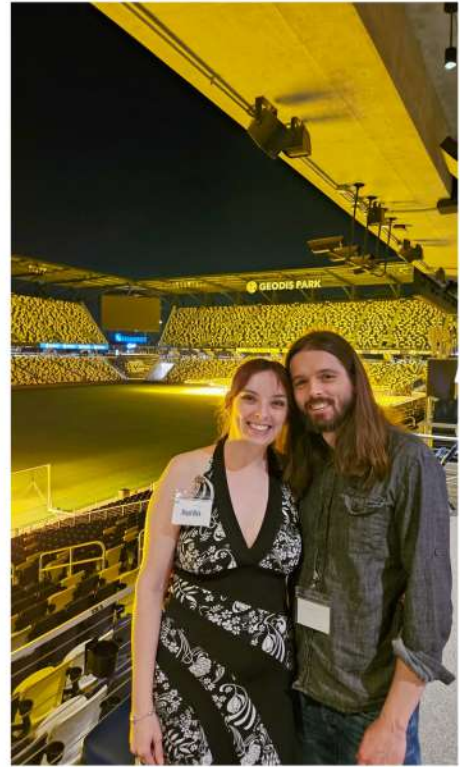
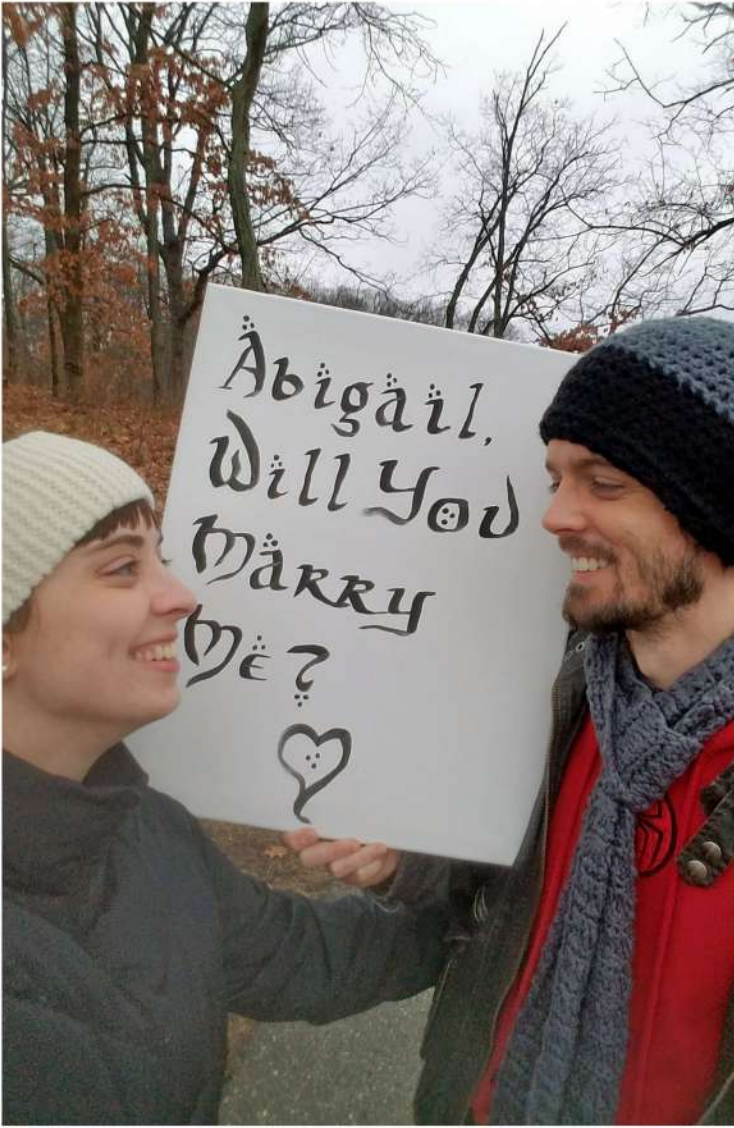

Abigail loves crafting, hiking, coffee, and gardening. These are some of the strawberries from her garden!

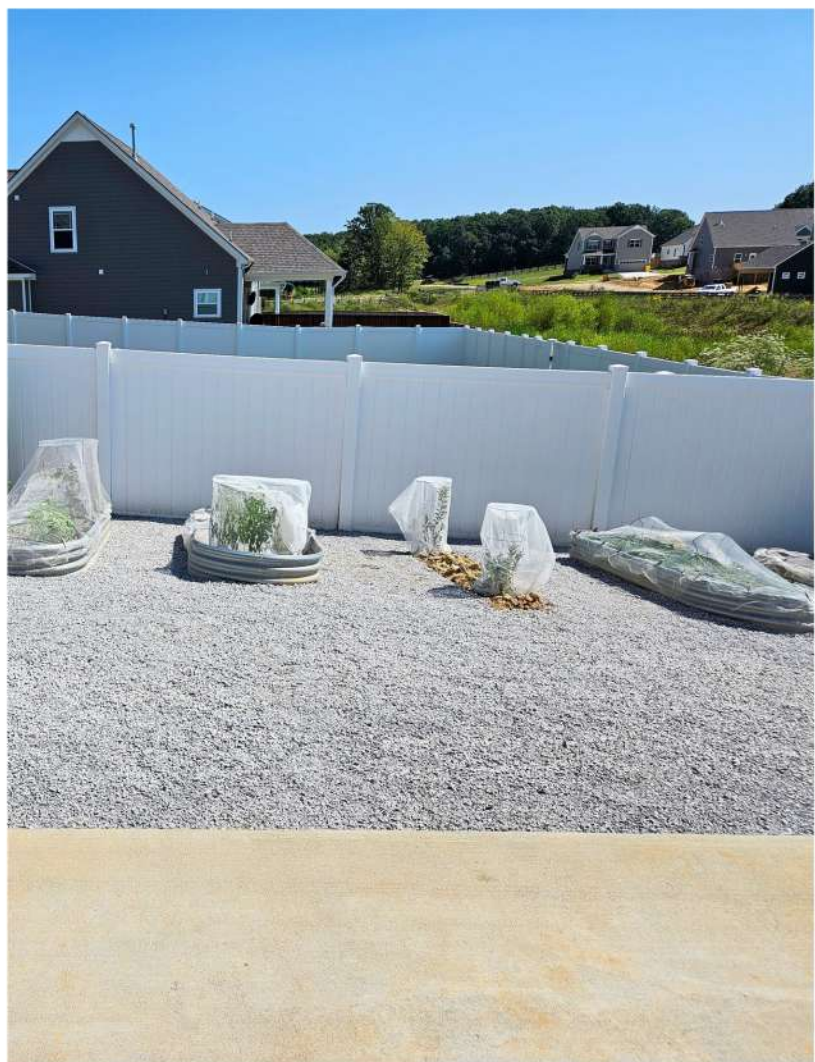

We have a great support system through family and friends.

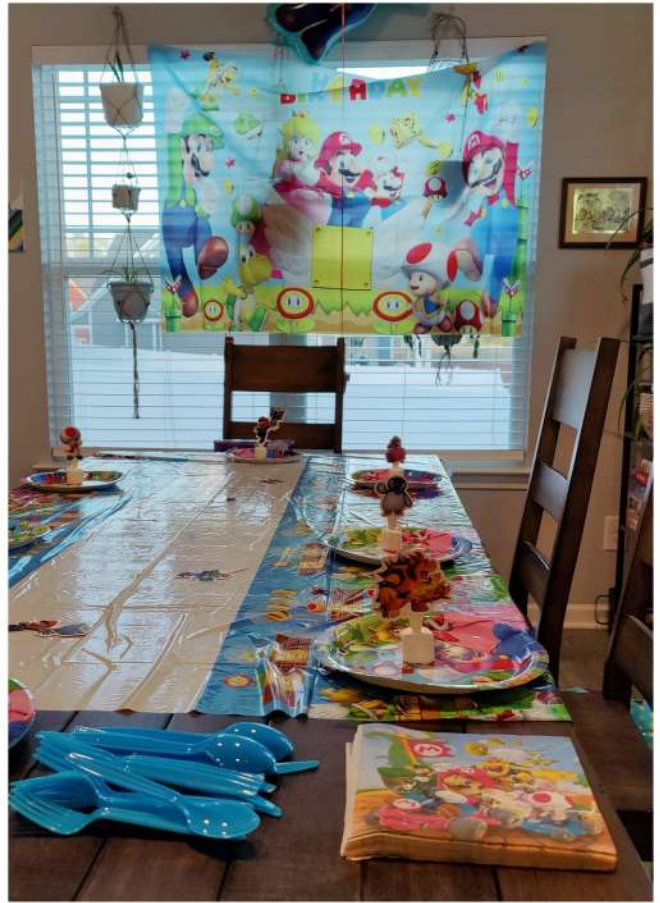

If we become a trans-racial family, we will be well supported by our **diverse** and **loving community!**



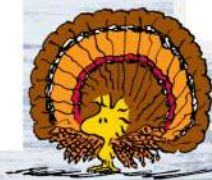


Holidays and Traditions

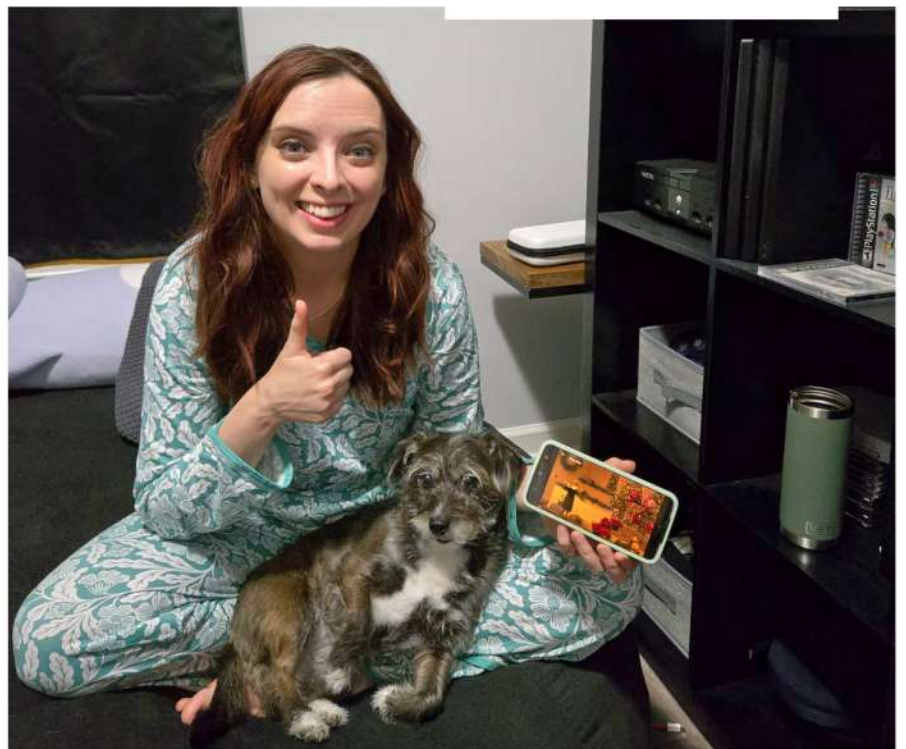
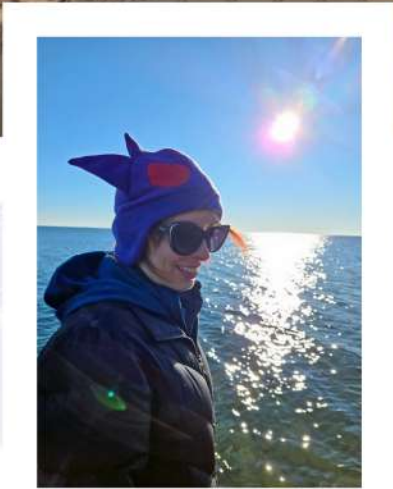
