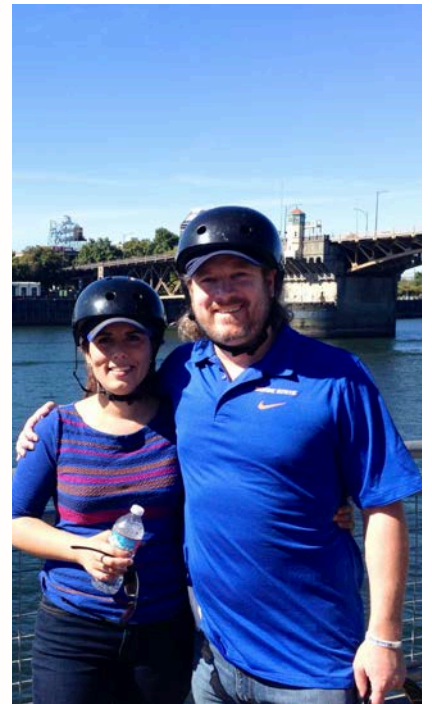
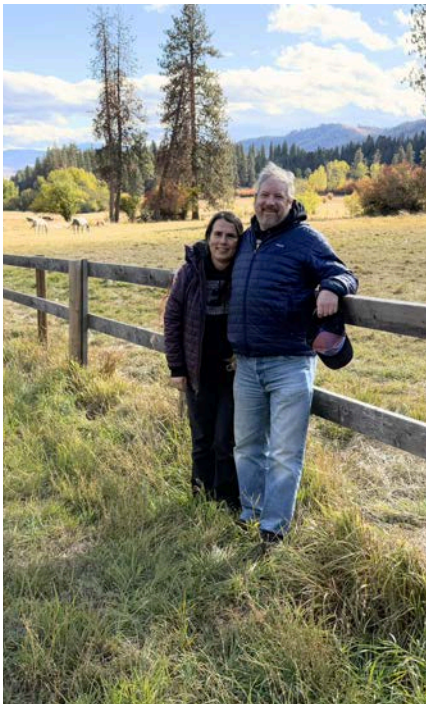


FOR FUN

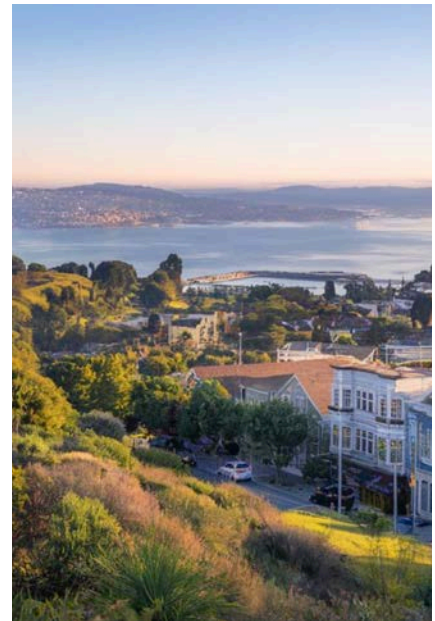
HOME SWEET HOME

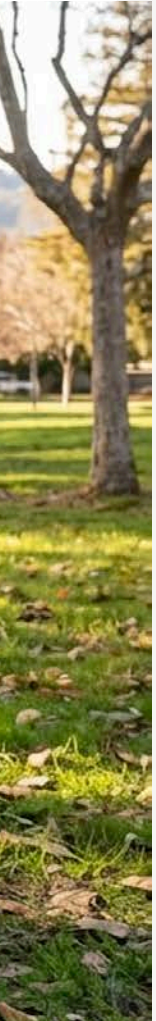

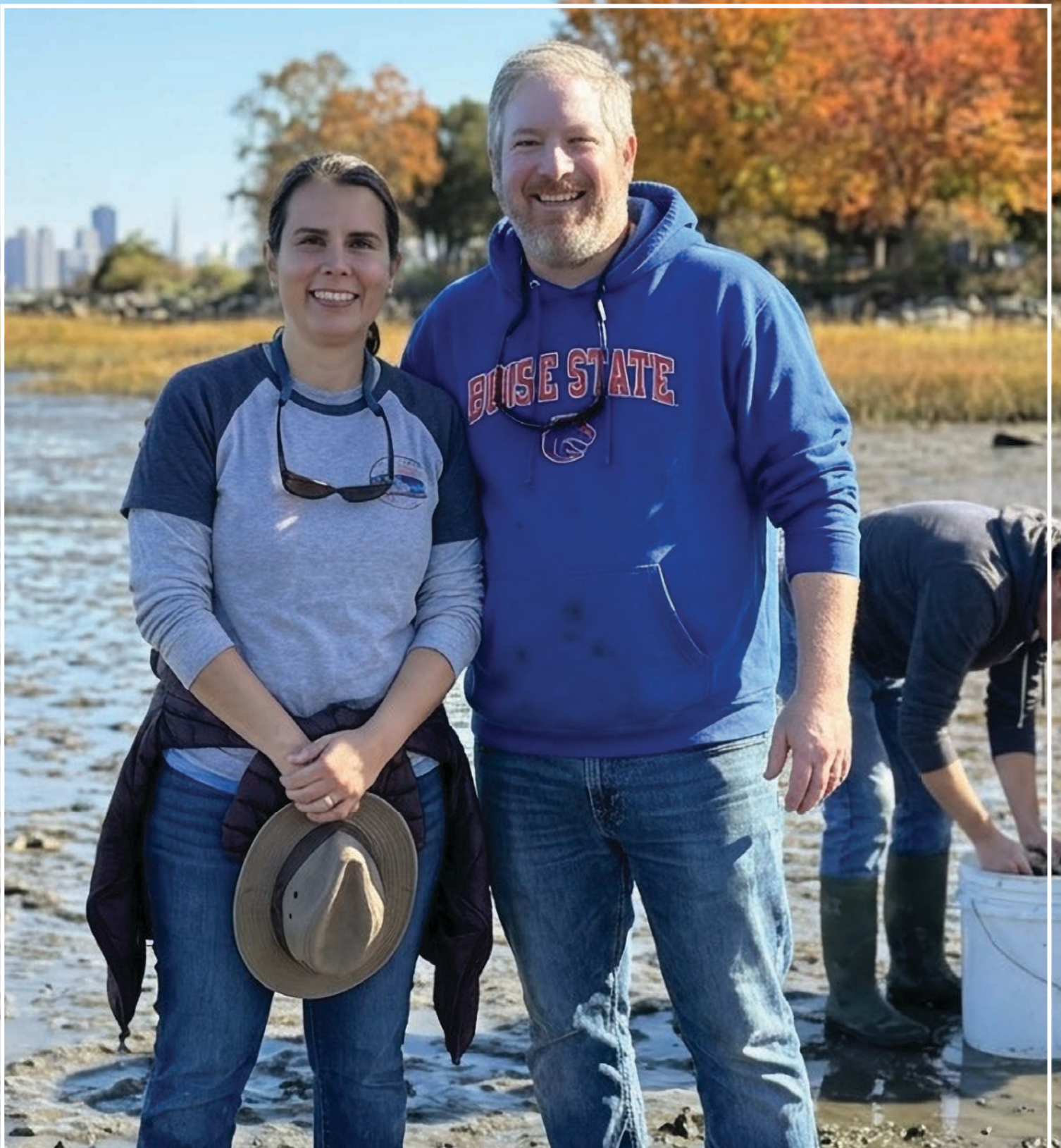

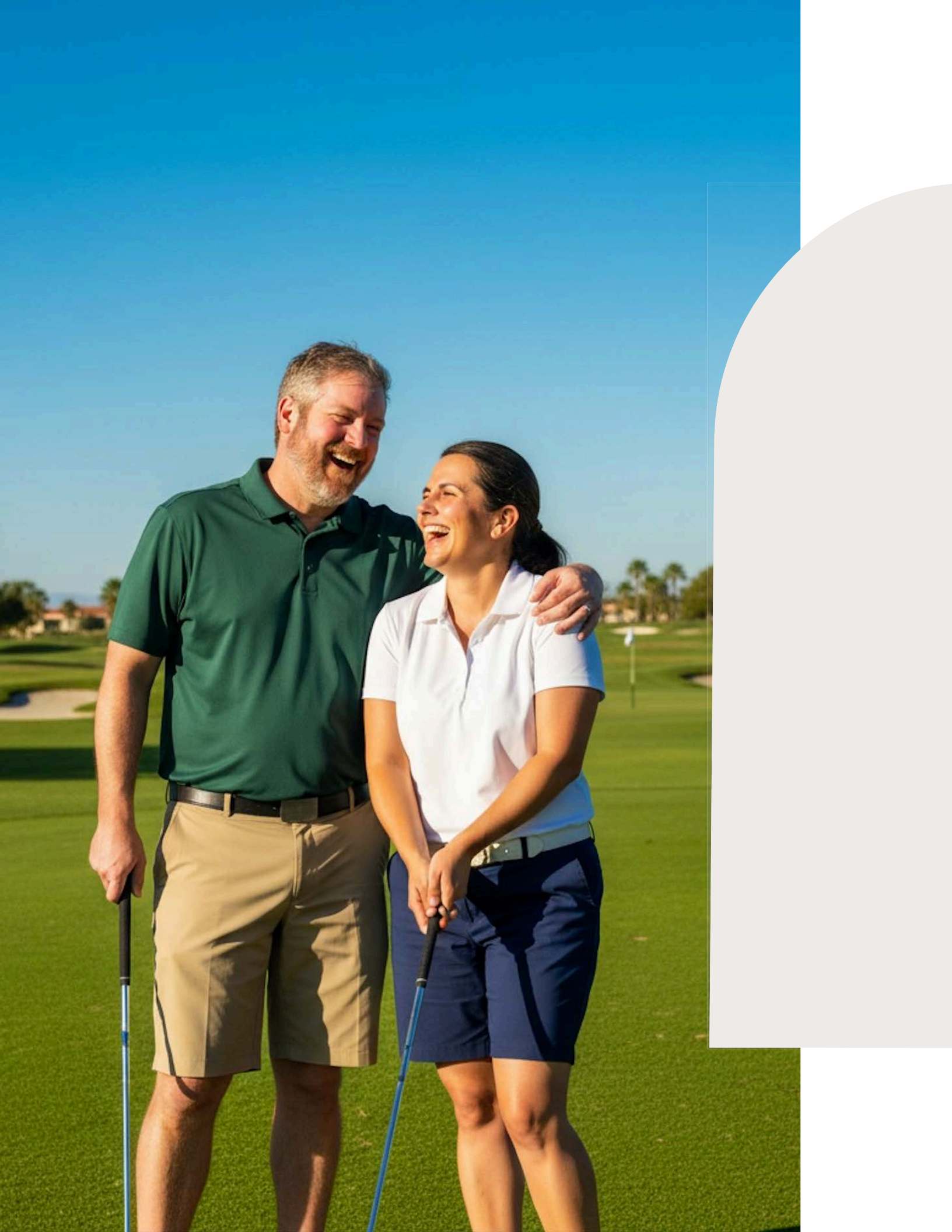
