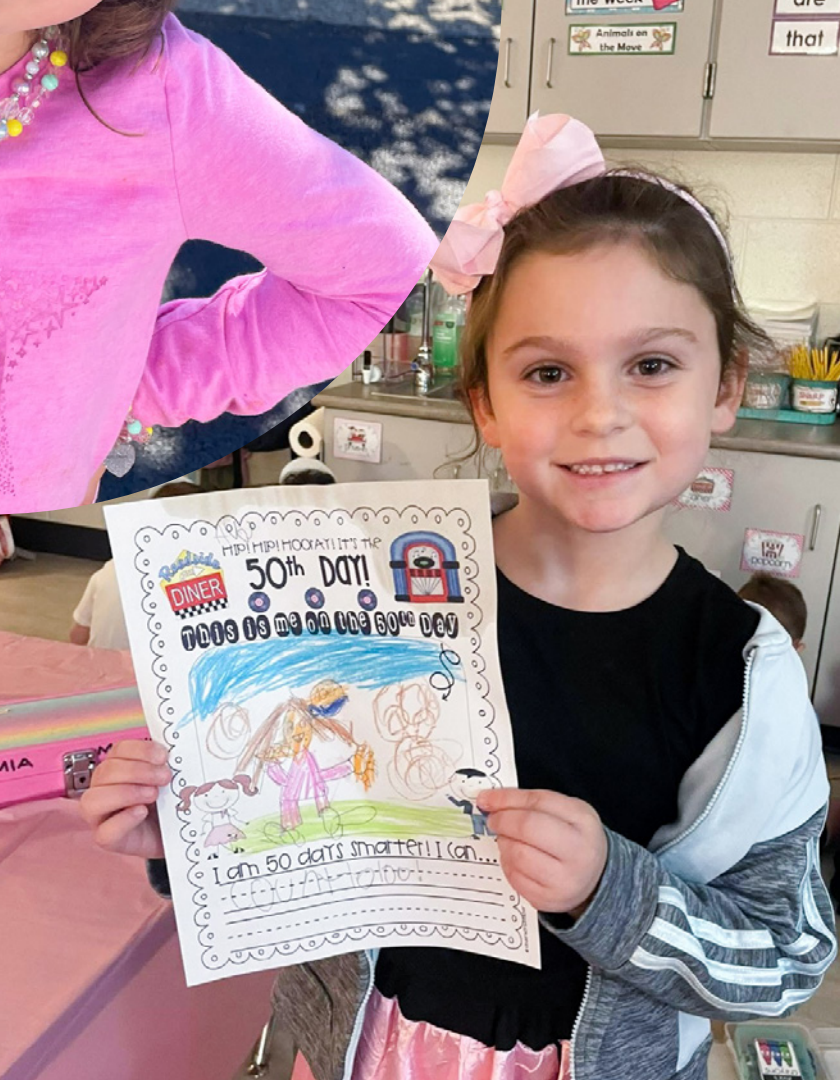


Adam

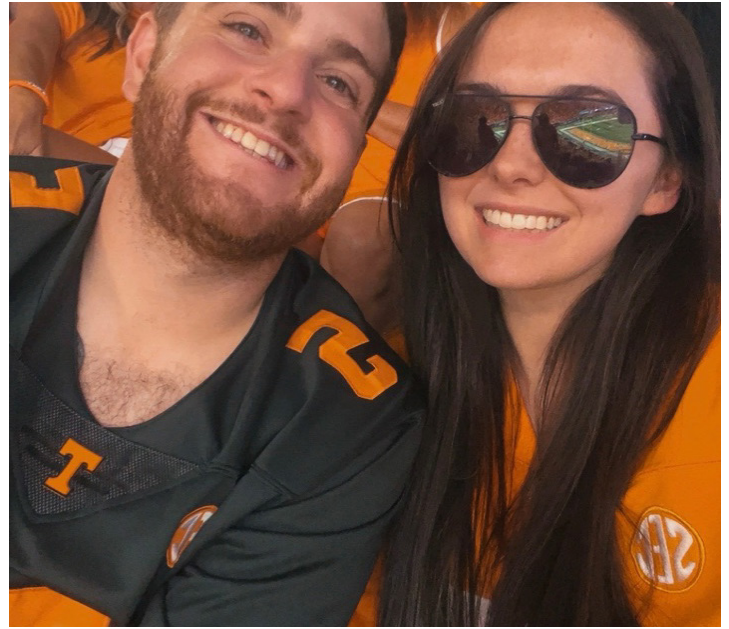
