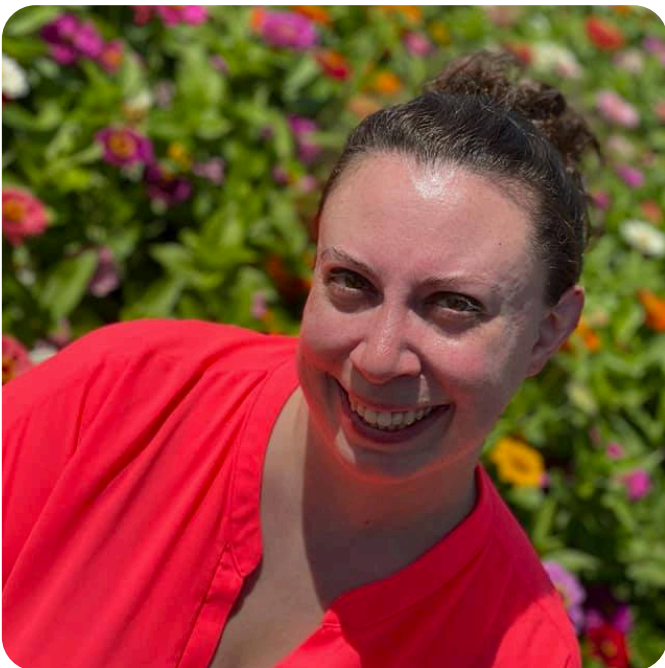
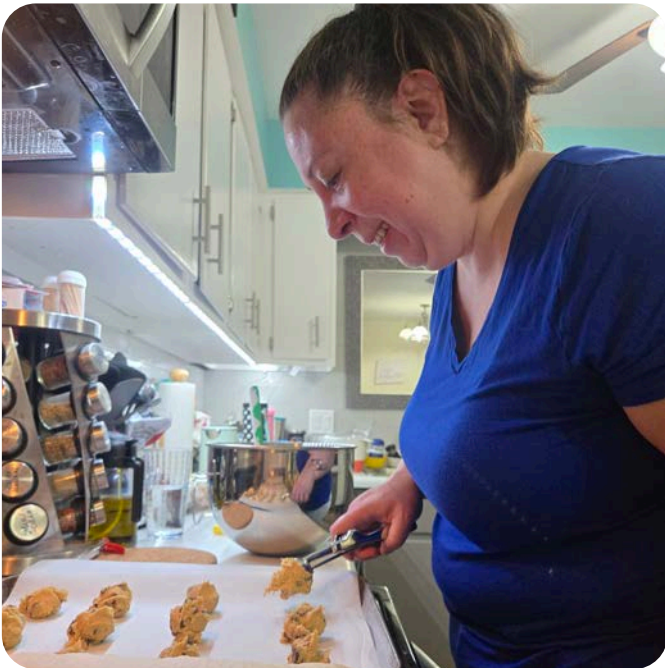

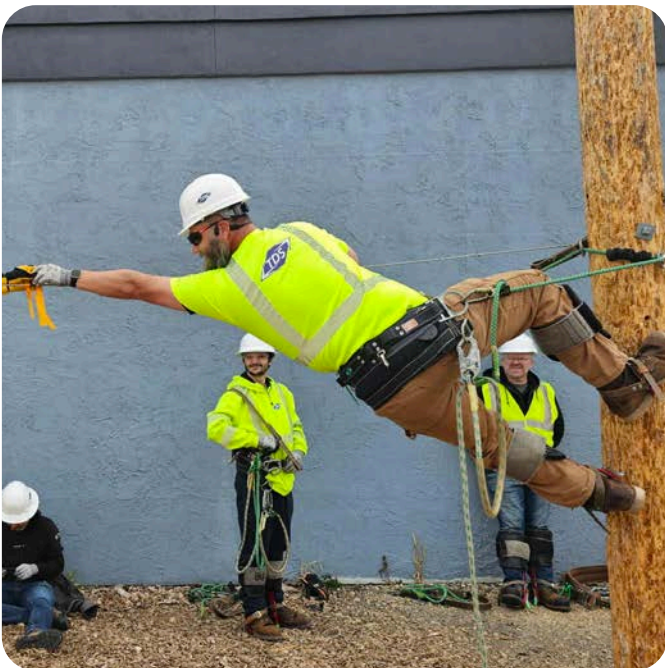


From Kayla's perspective

Our Home

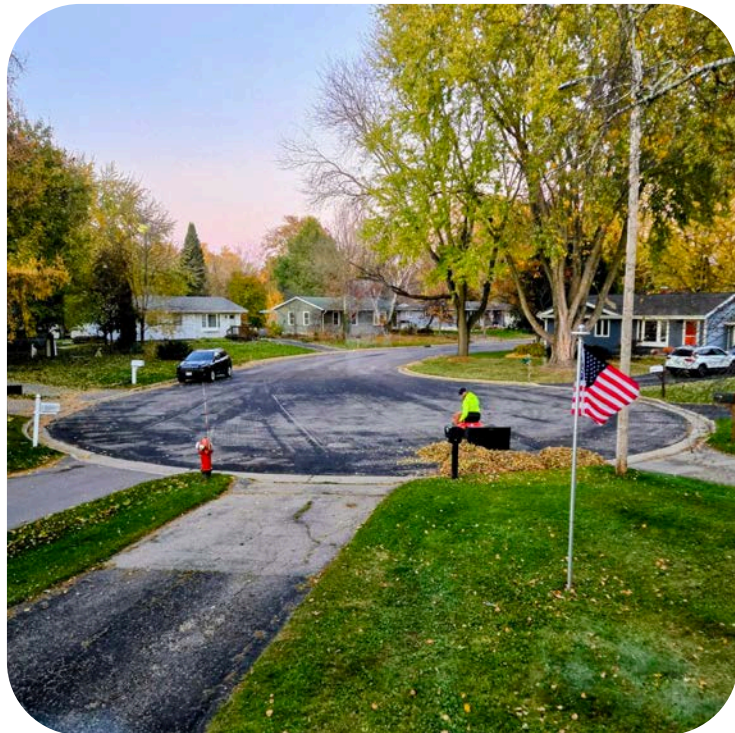


We live in a small cul-de-sac near Madison, Wisconsin. We have a large backyard with lots of room to play and grow!

We live in a growing community with lots of parks and ice cream shops! Kayla's aunt, uncle, and parents all live within a few blocks of us, so family is always nearby.

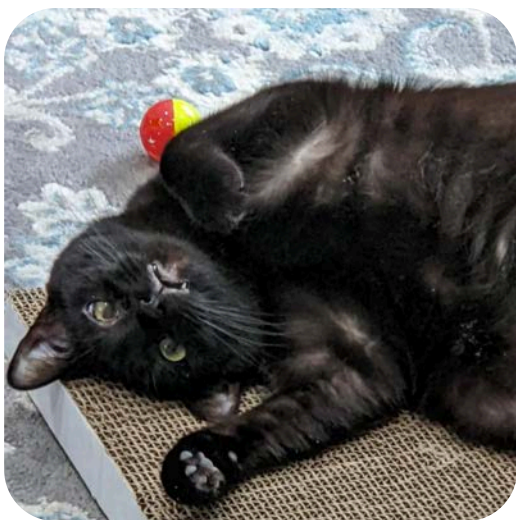

Our faith in God is important to us. We attend the church where Devin grew up and are leaders in the college-age group. We are excited to bring our children to church and to be involved in all the children's activities.

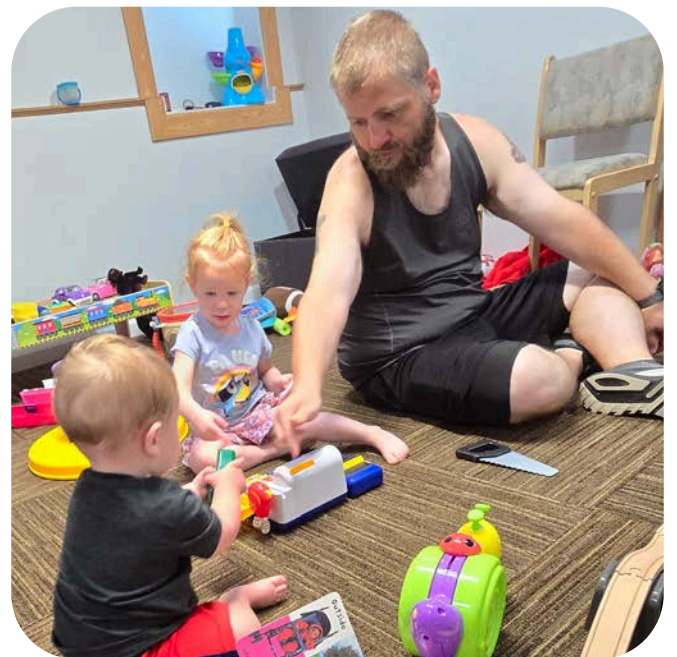


Community
